CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BEULAH B. (CARTER) BURTON 306 HARDCASH LANE CAMAS VALLEY, OREGON 97416

confirms the right to use the waters of MILL CREEK, a tributary of THE MIDDLE FORK OF THE COQUILLE RIVER, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY AND IRRIGATING 4.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 47366. The date of priority is JANUARY 31, 1983. The right is limited to not more than 0.055 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND BEING 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC AND 0.05 CFS FOR IRRIGATION or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 31, T 29 S, R 8 W, W.M.; 1420 FEET SOUTH AND 70 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The waters of the Middle Fork of the Coquille River and tributaries upstream from the confluence with Holmes Creek are classified only for domestic, livestock and irrigation of lawns and gardens not exceeding one-half acre in area, and instream use for recreation, fish life, and wildlife during the period from July 1 to September 30, of every year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
