THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH FORK DEER CREEK, a tributary of DEER CREEK, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE LAWN AND NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN.

The right has been perfected under Permit 47692. The date of priority is JULY 18, 1983. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 18, T 38 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 70 FEET NORTH AND 10 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 18.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4  
SECTION 18  
TOWNSHIP 38 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
