confirms the right to use the waters of BULL RUN CREEK, a tributary of SOUTH FORK BURNT RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 18.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for BAKER County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 8, at page 134. The date of priority is 1897.

This right is limited to 0.45 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4 18.0 ACRES
SECTION 13
TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by certificate 5847, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 29, 1991, approving transfer application 6128.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
