CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of DIAMOND CREEK, a tributary of NEAL CREEK, for the purpose of TEMPERATURE CONTROL AND FROST PROTECTION FOR 25.6 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 46314. The date of priority is AUGUST 3, 1981. The right is limited to not more than 2.86 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, BEING 2.86 CFS FOR FROST PROTECTION FROM MARCH 1 THROUGH JUNE 1 AND 0.32 CFS FOR TEMPERATURE CONTROL FROM JUNE 1 THROUGH OCTOBER 1, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 24, T 2 N, R 10 E, W.M.; 1250 FEET SOUTH AND 1000 FEET EAST FROM W 1/4 CORNER SECTION 24.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 22.4 ACRES
NW 1/4 SW 1/4 3.2 ACRES
SECTION 24
TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
