confirms the right to store the waters of DAIRY WASTE, a tributary of the LONG TOM RIVER, in HORNING LAGOONS 1 AND 2, appropriated under Permit 49024, for the purpose of IRRIGATION.

The right to store these waters has been perfected under Reservoir Permit R-10060. The date of priority is DECEMBER 10, 1984. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right is not more than 12.6 ACRE-FEET, BEING 6.0 AC-FT IN LAGOON 1 AND 6.6 AC-FT IN LAGOON 2.

The reservoirs are located as follows:

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
