CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED CREEK aka SCHOOLHOUSE CREEK, a tributary of WINCHUCK RIVER, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY AND IRRIGATING 3.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 49606. The date of priority is AUGUST 22, 1985. The right is limited to not more than 0.025 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC AND 0.02 CFS FOR IRRIGATION or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 2 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4), SECTION 6, T 41 S, R 12 W, W.M.; 100 FEET SOUTH AND 200 FEET WEST FROM THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF LOT 2 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4).

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

LOT 2 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4) 0.8 ACRE
SW 1/4 NE 1/4 2.2 ACRES AND DOMESTIC
SECTION 6
TOWNSHIP 41 SOUTH, RANGE 12 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
