CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAMS, OREGON 97544

confirms the right to use the waters of A RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-8837, a tributary of WILLIAMS CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 9.5 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 47765. The date of priority is JULY 5, 1983. The right is limited to not more than 4.0 ACRE FEET STORED WATER ONLY or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 24, T 38 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 1450 FEET SOUTH AND 280 FEET EAST FROM THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 24.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 2.0 ACRES
SW 1/4 NW 1/4 7.5 ACRES
SECTION 24
TOWNSHIP 38 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
