confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 1 in the DESCHUTES RIVER BASIN for the purpose of SANITARY PURPOSES AND MAINTENANCE OF A FIRE PROTECTION SYSTEM.

The right has been perfected under Permit G-10525. The date of priority is DECEMBER 20, 1984. The right is limited to not more than 25 GALLONS PER MINUTE, BEING FURTHER LIMITED TO 2800 GALLONS PER DAY FOR SANITARY PURPOSES AND A MAXIMUM OF 30,000 GPD FOR MAINTENANCE OF THE FIRE PROTECTION SYSTEM, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 11, T 18 S, R 13 E, W.M.; 1146 FEET NORTH AND 2168 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 11.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4
SECTION 11
TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
