CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CRATER LAKE ORCHARDS
P.O. BOX 129
MEDFORD, OREGON 97501

confirms the right to use the waters of ANTELOPE CREEK, a tributary of LITTLE BUTTE CREEK, for the purpose of TEMPERATURE CONTROL FOR 63.7 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit 41303. The date of priority is MAY 11, 1972. This right is limited to 3.4 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 30, T 36 S, R 1 E, W.M.; SOUTH 24 DEGREES 30 MINUTES WEST, 980 FEET FROM THE NE CORNER OF THE SW 1/4 NE 1/4 OF SECTION 30.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4 17.5 ACRES
SW 1/4 SE 1/4 13.0 ACRES
BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 37
SECTION 29

LOT 5 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4) 0.8 ACRE
NE 1/4 NE 1/4 2.8 ACRES
NW 1/4 NE 1/4 19.4 ACRES
NE 1/4 NW 1/4 10.2 ACRES
ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 37
SECTION 32
TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
