CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PAUL G. WARES

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH CATHERINE CREEK, a tributary of CATHERINE CREEK, for the purpose of THE SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 94.0 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit 46456. The date of priority is AUGUST 5, 1981. This right is limited to 2.35 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 24, T 5 S, R 42 E, W.M.; 90 FEET NORTH AND 1150 FEET WEST FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 24.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4	21.0 ACRES
NW 1/4 NE 1/4	1.4 ACRES
SW 1/4 NE 1/4	4.4 ACRES
SE 1/4 NE 1/4	19.0 ACRES
NE 1/4 NW 1/4	12.6 ACRES
NW 1/4 NW 1/4	16.3 ACRES
SW 1/4 NW 1/4	2.0 ACRES
SE 1/4 NW 1/4	17.3 ACRES

SECTION 24
TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 41 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
