CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING, a tributary of SELDER CREEK (AKA MCGILL CREEK), for DOMESTIC USE FOR A HOUSE, A MOBILE HOME AND A BARN.

This right was perfected under Permit 51095. The date of priority is JUNE 20, 1990. This right is limited to not more than 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 32, T 5 N, R 5 W, W.M.; 420 FEET SOUTH AND 890 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 32.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4
SECTION 32
TOWNSHIP 5 NORTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
