confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the MOSIER CREEK BASIN for the IRRIGATION OF 20.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-341. The date of priority is JULY 19, 1956. This right is limited to 0.25 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 7, T 2 N, R 12 E, W.M.; 1350 FEET SOUTH AND 2750 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 7.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 12 EAST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 4, 1985 and supersedes Certificate 30641, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
