CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the WEST FORK SILVIES RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATING 88.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit U-407. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 10, 1951. This right is limited to 1.11 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 27, T 25 S, R 30 E, W.M.; WELL 1 - 70 FEET NORTH AND 10 FEET WEST FROM THE CENTER 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4	9.5 ACRES
SE 1/4 NE 1/4	14.0 ACRES
NE 1/4 NW 1/4	15.2 ACRES
SE 1/4 NW 1/4	32.0 ACRES
NW 1/4 SE 1/4	18.0 ACRES
SECTION 27	
TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 30 EAST, W.M.	

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 44378, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 25, 1991, approving Transfer Application 6473.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
