CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LEONARD SKIP MELVILLE  
HCR 61  
ENTERPRISE, OREGON 97828

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS in the WALLOWA RIVER BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATING 109.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit G-10347. The dates of priority are OCTOBER 14, 1983 FOR 5.6 GALLONS PER MINUTE AND FEBRUARY 10, 1984 FOR 594.4 GPM. The right is limited to not more than 600 GALLONS PER MINUTE or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 29, T 1 S, R 45 E, W.M.;  
WELL 1 - 1430 FEET NORTH AND 430 FEET WEST, WELL 2 - 350 FEET NORTH AND 340 FEET WEST, BOTH FROM THE S 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4	20.5 ACRES
NE 1/4 SW 1/4	25.1 ACRES
SE 1/4 SW 1/4	38.6 ACRES
SW 1/4 SW 1/4	24.8 ACRES

SECTION 29  
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 45 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
