confirms the right to use the waters of A SUMP in the WILLOW CREEK BASIN for the purpose of SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 67.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit G-10467. The date of priority is JANUARY 7, 1985. The right is limited to not more than 0.84 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The sump is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 13, T 16 S, R 43 E, W.M.; 1740 FEET NORTH AND 20 FEET WEST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 30.2 ACRES SE 1/4 NW 1/4 36.8 ACRES SECTION 24 TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 43 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
