## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LEONARD AND ELIZABETH HELSETH 1325 MOSIER CREEK ROAD MOSIER, OREGON 97040

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO SPRINGS, tributaries of MOSIER CREEK, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF LAWN AND GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED 1/2 ACRE IN AREA.

This right has been perfected under Permit 43002. The date of priority is MARCH 27, 1978. This right is limited to 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, WATER TO BE DIVERTED FROM SPRING 1 WHEN AVAILABLE WITH ANY DEFICIENCY IN SUPPLY FROM SPRING 1 TO BE MADE UP BY DIVERSION FROM SPRING 2, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 12, T 2 N , R 11 E, W.M.; 1 - 350 FEET NORTH AND 820 FEET WEST, 2 - 190 FEET NORTH AND 710 FEET WEST, BOTH FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 12.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4 SECTION 12 TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
