CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

TERRY AND JUDY MCCURDY

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED SPRING, a tributary of OLALLA CREEK, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF LAWN AND GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE IN AREA.

The right has been perfected under Permit 43792. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 8, 1978. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 32, T 29 S, R 7 W, W.M.; 700 FEET SOUTH AND 80 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 32.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4
SECTION 32
TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
