CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO  
DESCHUTES VALLEY WATER DISTRICT  
ROUTE 1, BOX 17  
MADRAS, OREGON 97741

confirms the right to use the waters of CROOKED RIVER, a tributary of  
DESCHUTES RIVER, for the purpose of DEVELOPMENT OF 493.2 T.H.P. TO POWER  
A WATER DRIVEN TURBINE PUMP.

This right has been perfected under Permit 43521. The date of priority  
is OCTOBER 20, 1977. This right is limited to 140.0 CUBIC FEET PER  
SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of  
diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 33, T 12 S, R 12 E, W.M.; 440 FEET  
SOUTH AND 2030 FEET WEST FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 33.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by  
the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this  
right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4  
SECTION 33  
TOWNSHIP 12 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to  
beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is  
subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission  
with an effective date prior to this right.
