CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RODNEY D. AND KELLY WOHLCKE
DAYVILLE, OREGON 97825

confirms the right to use the waters of WASTE WATER FROM CUMMINGS DITCH COLLECTED IN OLD DAYVILLE DITCH, a tributary of JOHN DAY RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 0.2 ACRE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 44968. The date of priority is MARCH 14, 1980. The right is limited to not more than 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 1, T 13 S, R 26 E, W.M.; 1800 FEET NORTH AND 940 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 1.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year AND SHALL ALSO BE LIMITED TO THE WATER AT THE POINT OF DIVERSION, AND SHALL NOT CARRY WITH IT THE RIGHT TO COMPEL THE CONTINUANCE OF THE WASTE WATER.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 0.2 ACRE
SECTION 1
TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 26 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
