## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the HEATON CREEK BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 15.1 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit G-10275. The date of priority is OCTOBER 14, 1983. This right is limited to 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 29, T 2 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 1960 FEET SOUTH AND 1350 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 2.3 ACRES SW 1/4 NE 1/4 12.8 ACRES SECTION 29 TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
