CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

W.D. MORGAN AND LLOYD DOSS ROUTE 1, BOX 500 IMNAHA, OREGON 97828

confirms the right to use the waters of IMNAHA RIVER, a tributary of SNAKE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 0.8 ACRE.

This right has been perfected under Permit 42934. The date of priority is MARCH 13, 1978. This right is limited to 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 21, T 1 N, R 48 E, W.M.; 1 - 50 FEET SOUTH AND 540 FEET EAST; 2 - 150 FEET SOUTH AND 540 FEET EAST; BOTH FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 16.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 4.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.4 ACRE SECTION 16

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 0.4 ACRE SECTION 21
TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 48 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
