confirms the right to use the waters of CANYON CREEK, a tributary of JOHN DAY RIVER, for the purpose of SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 0.4 ACRE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 48124. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 23, 1983. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 4 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4), SECTION 1, T 14 S, R 31 E, W.M.; 250 FEET SOUTH AND 340 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF LOT 4 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4), SECTION 1.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

LOT 4 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4) 0.4 ACRE SECTION 1
TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
