CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE OF LAWN AND NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN, BEING FURTHER LIMITED TO THE IRRIGATION OF ONLY THE NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN DURING THE PERIOD JULY 15 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30 OF EACH YEAR.

The right has been perfected under Permit 49625. The date of priority is DECEMBER 27, 1985. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 9, T 30 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 710 FEET NORTH AND 310 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 9.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4  
SECTION 10  
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
