CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the BEAVER CREEK BASIN for the purpose of PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 4.5 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 3.8 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit G-10239. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 22, 1983. The right is limited to not more than 0.07 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 4, T 40 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 900 FEET NORTH AND 350 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 4.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

TOWNSHIP 40 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
