confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the PINE CREEK BASIN for the purpose of PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 19.3 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 158.3 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit G-10560. The date of priority is JUNE 10, 1985. The right is limited to not more than 1.83 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 27, T 6 N, R 34 E, W.M.; 470 FEET NORTH AND 1250 FEET EAST FROM THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
