## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PETER B. SERAFIN P.O. BOX 2250 ROSEBURG, OREGON 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of LITTLE RIVER, a tributary of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 1.0 ACRE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 47787. The date of priority is APRIL 22, 1983. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 19, T 26 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 1830 FEET SOUTH AND 2840 FEET WEST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 19, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 42.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 0.9 ACRE
SE 1/4 NW 1/4 0.1 ACRE
BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 42
SECTION 19
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

MORE EXPLICITLY DESCRIBED AS LOT 9, GLIDE PLAT C

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
