CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

TONY B. AND MARIA J. PERIERA

confirms the right to use the waters of DAYS CREEK, a tributary of THE SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 1.2 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 49414. The date of priority is JUNE 26, 1985. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 49, SECTION 11, T 30 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 590 FEET SOUTH AND 530 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This right is further limited during the period of July 15 through September 30 of each year to the irrigation of a non-commercial garden no to exceed 1/2 acre.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 1.2 ACRES
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 49
SECTION 11
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
