CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

2005 MURPHY CREEK ROAD

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM WITH ANY DEFICIENCY IN THE AVAILABLE SUPPLY OF WATER FROM THE UNNAMED STREAM TO BE MADE UP BY APPROPRIATION FROM MURPHY CREEK AND A RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-8653, a tributary of APPLGATE RIVER, for the purpose of FISH CULTURE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 47522. The date of priority is JANUARY 21, 1983. The right is limited to not more than 0.1 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

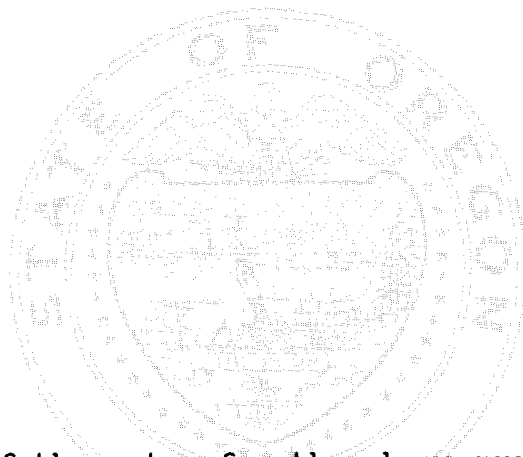
The points of diversion are located as follows:

LOT 7 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4), LOT 8 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4), SECTION 2, T 38 S, R 6 W, W.M.; UNNAMED STREAM - 820 FEET SOUTH AND 830 FEET EAST FROM THE N 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 2; MURPHY CREEK - 1060 FEET SOUTH AND 740 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 2.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

LOT 8 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4)
SECTION 2
TOWNSHIP 38 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.



The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
