confirms the right to use the waters of ONE SUMP WELL in the ALTHOUSE CREEK BASIN for the purpose of FROST PROTECTION FOR 3.5 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit G-10519. The date of priority is JULY 15, 1985. The right is limited to not more than 111 GALLONS PER MINUTE or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 7, T 40 S, R 7 W, W.M.; 2240 FEET SOUTH AND 420 FEET EAST FROM THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 7.

Use of water under this right shall be limited to the appropriation of water only to the extent that such appropriation does not interfere with or deplete the flow of Althouse Creek. Any depletion will require that use from the sump be shut down, since Althouse Creek has been closed to appropriation except for domestic, mining and power where no consumption of water is to be made.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 3.5 ACRES FROST PROTECTION SECTION 7
TOWNSHIP 40 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
