CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING AND THE SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, tributaries of the UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR TWO FAMILIES INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE OF LAWN AND NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN.

This right has been perfected under Permit 42066. The date of priority is MAY 23, 1977. This right is limited to 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FROM THE SPRING WHEN AVAILABLE, WITH ANY DEFICIENCY IN THE AVAILABLE SUPPLY FROM THE SPRING TO BE MADE UP FROM THE SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 27, T 30 S, R 2 W, W.M.; SPRING - 350 FEET NORTH AND 580 FEET EAST, RIVER - 150 FEET SOUTH AND 350 FEET EAST, BOTH FROM THE SW CORNER OF THE NW 1/4 SW 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 27.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4 TWO FAMILIES
SECTION 27
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
