CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of JUMP OFF JOE CREEK, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY.

The right has been perfected under Permit 44574. The date of priority is DECEMBER 10, 1979. The right is limited to not more than 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 24, T 35 S, R 7 W, W.M.; 140 FEET SOUTH AND 1350 FEET WEST FROM THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 24.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4
SECTION 24
TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.



The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
