## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ELMER AND JOANN JOHNSON BOX 335 MT. VERNON, OREGON 97865

confirms the right to use the waters of JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 2.1 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 47915. The date of priority is JULY 11, 1983. The right is limited to not more than 0.05 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 19, T 13 S, R 29 E, W.M.; 460 FEET NORTH AND 220 FEET WEST FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 0.6 ACRE NE 1/4 SE 1/4 0.3 ACRE SECTION 19

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 0.7 ACRE NW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.5 ACRE SECTION 20 TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 29 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
