CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of WILLOW CREEK RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-8508, a tributary of DREWS CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 12.6 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit 47069. The date of priority is JUNE 20, 1975. This right is limited to NOT MORE THAN 37.5 ACRE-FEET STORED WATER ONLY or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 5, T 40 S, R 18 E, W.M.; 1280 FEET SOUTH AND 110 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 5.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from storage.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 0.3 ACRE SE 1/4 NW 1/4 12.3 ACRES SECTION 4 TOWNSHIP 40 SOUTH, RANGE 18 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
