CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MANLEY WATSON  
BOX 54  
DRAIN, OREGON 97435

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM AND AN UNNAMED RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-7786, both tributaries of FITCH CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 0.1 ACRE, DOMESTIC USE FOR TWO FAMILIES AND COMMERCIAL USE IN A TRUCK SHOP.

The right has been perfected under Permit 43843. The date of priority is OCTOBER 30, 1978. The right is limited to not more than 0.015 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.005 CFS FOR EACH USE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 33, T 21 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 370 FEET NORTH AND 70 FEET WEST FROM THE S 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 33.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 0.1 ACRE DOMESTIC, SHOP  
SECTION 4  
TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
