CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RICK AND WENDY FOSTER
276 CORN CREEK ROAD
DAYS CREEK, OREGON 97429

confirms the right to use the waters of CORN CREEK, a tributary of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 0.6 ACRE.

This right has been perfected under Permit 45613. The date of priority is MARCH 11, 1981. This right is limited to 0.008 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 26, T 30 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 1360 FEET SOUTH AND 900 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 26.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 0.2 ACRE
SE 1/4 NE 1/4 0.4 ACRE
SECTION 26
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
