CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DAN McLOUD 1390 FISH HATCHERY ROAD GRANTS PASS, OREGON 97526

confirms the right to use the waters of APPLEGATE RIVER AND APPLEGATE LAKE RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-7810, tributaries of the ROGUE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 1.5 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit 46078. The date of priority is AUGUST 10, 1981. This right is limited to 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FROM APPLEGATE RIVER AND 4.0 ACRE-FEET STORED WATER ONLY FROM APPLEGATE LAKE RESERVOIR or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 15, T 37 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 2400 FEET NORTH AND 820 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 15. APPLEGATE DAM LOCATED WITHIN THE S 1/2 SE 1/4, SECTION 25, T 40 S, R 4 W, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) from direct flow and 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage.

The right is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 1-07-10-W0334 or a satisfactory replacement between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.

This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 0.7 ACRE NE 1/4 SE 1/4 0.8 ACRE SECTION 15

TOWNSHIP 37 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
