CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of WASHINGTON GULCH CREEK, a tributary of POWDER RIVER, for the purpose of MAINTAINING GREEN GULCH RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-10616 FOR FISH CULTURE.

This right has been perfected under Permit 49646. The date of priority is DECEMBER 9, 1985. This right is limited to 10.0 GALLONS PER MINUTE or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 11, T 9 S, R 39 E, W.M.; 120 FEET NORTH AND 480 FEET EAST FROM THE W 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 11.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4
SECTION 11
TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 39 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
