CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN AMERIN
ROUTE 2, BOX 263
HILLSBORO, OR 97123

confirms the right to use the waters of the TUALATIN RIVER, a tributary of the WILLAMETTE RIVER, for IRRIGATING 26.24 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 22028. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 11, 1953. This right is limited to 0.33 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 61, SECTION 16, T 1 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 650 FEET SOUTH AND 2350 FEET WEST FROM THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 16.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SECTION 16	
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.	

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by certificate 23092, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 24, 1991, approving transfer application 6230.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
