CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

U.S. ROGUE RIVER NATIONAL FOREST

confirms the right to store the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, TRIBUTARY OF ARMSTRONG GULCH, in ARMSTRONG POND (SPRING) RESERVOIR, for LIVESTOCK AND WILDLIFE.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-10057. The date of priority is JULY 1, 1982. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right shall not exceed 0.3 ACRE FOOT.

The reservoir is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4
SECTION 2
TOWNSHIP 40 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
