CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to store the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, TRIBUTARY OF THOMPSON CREEK, in FALLS ROAD POND, DEAD COW POND AND THOMPSON FALLS POND RESERVOIRS for LIVESTOCK.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-10555. The date of priority is AUGUST 15, 1983. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right shall not exceed 0.375 ACRE-FOOT, BEING 0.064 AF IN FALLS ROAD POND RESERVOIR, 0.278 AF IN DEAD COW POND RESERVOIR AND 0.033 AF IN THOMPSON FALLS POND RESERVOIR.

The reservoirs are located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4
SECTION 27

SW 1/4 SW 1/4
NE 1/4 NW 1/4
SECTION 26

TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 29 EAST, W.M.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
