CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to store the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, TRIBUTARY OF PASS CREEK, in SL-10A RESERVOIR, for LIVESTOCK.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-10840. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 26, 1983. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right shall not exceed 0.2 ACRE-FOOT ANNUALLY DURING THE NON-IRRIGATION SEASON OR WHEN EXCESS WATER IS OTHERWISE AVAILABLE.

The reservoir is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4
SECTION 4
TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, W.M.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
