CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RAYMOND L. AND LORETTA R. FROST  
4001 DEER CREEK ROAD  
SELMA, OREGON 97538

confirms the right to use the waters of SUMP 3 in the DEER CREEK BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATING 10.0 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit G-9920. The date of priority is AUGUST 18, 1976. This right is limited to 0.13 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the sump.

The sump is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 8, T 38 S, R 7 W, W.M.; 1390 FEET NORTH AND 590 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 8.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with the prior surface water rights of others.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4	5.5 ACRES
SECTION 8	
NW 1/4 SW 1/4	4.5 ACRES
SECTION 9	
TOWNSHIP 38 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.	

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
