CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SPEEDY AND EDDIE NUTZ
1562 SLEEPY HOLLOW LOOP
GRANTS PASS, OREGON 97527

confirms the right to use the waters of APPELEGATE RIVER AND APPELEGATE LAKE RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-7810, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY AND IRRIGATION OF 1.5 ACRES FROM APPELEGATE RIVER AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 1.5 ACRES FROM APPELEGATE LAKE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 48037. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 8, 1983. The right is limited to not more than 0.025 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE AND 0.02 CFS FOR IRRIGATION or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 5, T 37 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 810 FEET NORTH AND 610 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 5. APPELEGATE DAM - SE 1/4 OF SECTION 25, T 40 S, R 4 W, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract No. 3-07-10-W0507, or a satisfactory replacement, between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.

This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 1.5 ACRES AND DOMESTIC
SECTION 5
TOWNSHIP 37 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
