CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That OLIVE STEWART of Paulina State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Beaver Creek, a tributary of Crooked River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 65 acres of land, and stock and domestic use,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 449; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1864 for the irrigation of fifty acres of land, and from 1892 for the irrigation of fifteen acres of land.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a reasonable amount for domestic and stock use, and 82/100 cubic foot per second from July 1st to September 15th of each year for irrigation. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

25 acres in the NW 1/4 of NE 1/4; 20 acres in the SW 1/4 of NE 1/4; 14 acres in the NW 1/4 of SE 1/4; 5 acres in the SW 1/4 of SE 1/4; 1 acre in the SE 1/4 of SE 1/4; Section Five (5), Township Seventeen (17) South Range Twenty-five (25) East of Willamette Meridian, in Crook County, Oregon.

Note: The limited irrigation season set forth herein is in error and should conform to the season as defined in the decree. See amendment filed adjacent to Certificate 815

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
