## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN A. CHANDLER ROUTE 1, BOX 79 RICHLAND, OREGON 97870

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED CREEK, a tributary of EAGLE CREEK, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 19.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 42336. The date of priority is AUGUST 15, 1977, FOR 0.425 CFS AND NOVEMBER 18, 1977, FOR 0.065 CFS. This right is limited to 0.49 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 15, T 9 S, R 45 E, W.M.; 150 FEET SOUTH AND 580 FEET EAST FROM THE CENTER 1/4 OF SECTION 15.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4 19.3 ACRES SECTION 15
TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 45 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
