CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROBERT D. CONLEY  
DAYS CREEK, OREGON 97429

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 3.2 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit 47776. The date of priority is AUGUST 9, 1983. This right is limited to 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 37, SECTION 30, T 30 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 1160 FEET NORTH AND 50 FEET WEST FROM THE NE 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 2.9 ACRES  
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 37  
SECTION 30

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 0.3 ACRE  
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 37  
SECTION 29  
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
