CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

VICTOR THUMBERG
ROUTE 1, BOX 186 D
CARLTON, OREGON 97111

confirms the right to use the waters of PANTHER CREEK, a tributary of YAMHILL RIVER to make up for any deficiency in the available supply from the unnamed stream allowed under Permit 35610 for maintenance of the reservoir constructed under Permits R-5570 and R-5729, for the purpose of FISH CULTURE.

This right has been perfected under Permit 48087. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 21, 1983. This right is limited to 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, PROVIDED THE TOTAL QUANTITY OF WATER DIVERTED FROM BOTH SOURCES SHALL NOT EXCEED 0.08 CFS, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 43, SECTION 25, T 3 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 1500 FEET SOUTH AND 650 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 25.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 43
SECTION 25
TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
