CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LARRY AND MARVIN PARLETTE HC 62, BOX 463 MADRAS, OREGON 97741

confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING, a tributary of ANTELOPE CREEK, for IRRIGATING 18.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 42530. The date of priority is JUNE 26, 1970. This right is limited to 0.24 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 25, T 8 S, R 15 E, W.M.; 890 FEET SOUTH AND 530 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 25.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 6.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 8.0 ACRES SECTION 25
TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 15 EAST, W.M.

LOT 1 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4) 10.3 ACRES SECTION 30 TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 16 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
