CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CHARLES J. AND MABEL V. LEIBELT BOX 55 NORWAY, OR 97460

confirms the right to use the waters of THE COQUILLE RIVER, a tributary of PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATING 192.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 38931. The date of priority is JANUARY 18, 1974. This right is limited to 2.4 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 2 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4), SECTION 31, T 28 S, R 12 W, W.M.; 800 FEET SOUTH AND 1150 FEET EAST FROM THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
