confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED SPRING, a tributary of PINT CREEK, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE IN 13 CAMPSITES AT RIPPLEBROOK CAMPGROUND.

The right has been perfected under Permit 48733. The date of priority is OCTOBER 1, 1982. The right is limited to not more than 5 GALLONS PER MINUTE or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 2 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4), SECTION 2, T 6 S, R 6 E, W.M.; 1380 FEET SOUTH AND 1630 WEST FROM THE NORTHEAST CORNER SECTION 2.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

N 1/2
SW 1/4
SECTION 2
TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 6 EAST, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
